- Humans have got basic five senses.

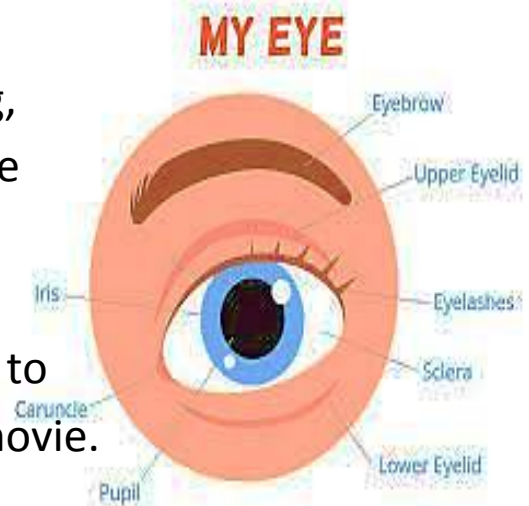
They are senses of touch, sight, hearing, smell and taste. The sense of sight is the ability to see objects around us.

Egypt were united by Menes Narmer who managed
